

## Economic Stabilization: Congress Passes CARES Act

Davis Polk has prepared two memos describing key portions of the bill just signed into law: the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ([CARES Act](#)). The Senate passed the bill late on Wednesday night, and the House passed it on Friday afternoon. The President signed it shortly afterwards. The Department of the Treasury, the Federal Reserve and other federal agencies now face the mammoth task of carrying out their new responsibilities.
