

Visual Memo: CFTC Proposes Amendments to Cross-Border Rules

On December 18, 2019, the CFTC proposed rules that would modify and codify the cross-border application of certain of its Title VII swap rules to both U.S. and non-U.S. registered swap dealers and major swap participants.
