

Revised Jurisdictional Thresholds Under the HSR Act and For the Prohibition of Interlocking Directorates - January 2012

January 27, 2012 | Client Update

The memorandum addresses recent changes to both the HSR premerger notification filing thresholds and the thresholds that trigger, under Section 8 of the Clayton Act, a prohibition preventing companies from having interlocking directorates, each of which were published today in the Federal Register. The new HSR notification thresholds will apply to all transactions which will close on or after February 27, 2012, and the Section 8 thresholds are effective today.
